### What is HeatShare?

HeatShare is a voluntary utility assistance program administered through The Salvation Army with assistance from MMU. HeatShare relies on tax-deductible donations from utility customers to help those in need. Funds contributed through this program will stay in our service area.

HeatShare provides funds for heating bills and heating-related repairs for eligible people:

- Senior citizens 55 years of age or older with low, fixed incomes and no alternative source of help.
- Disabled persons whose physical capabilities or health problems limit their income.
- Persons who meet income guidelines and have received or applied for all other possible public funds.
- Persons who have had an unexpected emergency within the last 12 months and as a result cannot pay their bills.
